| Sec. 238       | Report Detailing Compliance with Disclosure Requirements for Recipients of Research and Development Funds        | Directs DOD to submit a report to Congress showing they are in compliance with disclosure requirements for recipients of R&D funds as required by federal law.  |
| Sec. 240       | Research Security Training Requirement for Federal Research Grant Personnel                                      | Establishes a research security training requirement for Federal research grant personnel.  |
| Sec. 848       | Report on Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification Effects on Small Business                                   | Requires DOD to submit a report on the effects of the CMMC on small businesses.   |
| Sec. 1540      | Assessment of Controlled Unclassified Information Program  | Directs DOD to conduct a review of the implementation of its CUI program. The review would include an assessment of the DOD's compliance with DoDI 5200.48 and recommend changes to current statutes, policy, or regulations. |
| Sec. 6446      | Admission of Essential Scientists and Technical Experts to Promote and Protect National Security Innovation Base | Allows for admission of essential scientists and technical experts to promote and protect the national security innovation base.  |
| Sec. 6484      | National Academies Science, Technology, and Security Roundtable  | Directs the National Academies to study the feasibility of providing enhanced research security services to further protect the United States research enterprise against foreign interference, theft, and espionage.         |
| Sec. 6499E     | Malign Foreign Talent Recruitment Program Prohibition  | Prohibits malign talent recruitment program participants from receipt of research and development awards from Federal research agencies.  |
