Dear Chairmen Alexander and Upton, and Ranking Members Murray and Pallone:

AAU urges Congress to pass the 21st Century Cures Act during its current session.

AAU welcomes the legislation's "Innovation Fund" for the National Institutes of Health. This critical funding for NIH would assist our nation's premier health agency catch up from more than a decade of flat funding and ensure that the United States remains in the forefront of medical innovation. It would support thousands more researchers as they seek to advance discovery and innovation to find new treatments and cures for diseases.

In addition, AAU supports measures in the Cures Act that encourage the next generation of the biomedical research workforce. We applaud the inclusion of language establishing a Research Policy Group as well as directions for federal agencies to reduce the research regulatory burden without weakening oversight in such areas as animal welfare, sub-recipient monitoring, and financial conflict of interest reporting.

The tremendous bipartisan work in the House and Senate on the NIH package should not go unfulfilled. AAU and its 62 research universities look forward to working with Congress to realize the Cures promise in the years ahead.
