

Locating Estimates that Changed in the Report

Tables 1 and 2 provide the estimates that were revised because of the coding error. These estimates include the prevalence rates and the number of victims for

- Nonconsensual penetration by force only since entering college (NPF)
- Nonconsensual attempted penetration by force since entering college (NAPF)

No other estimates in the report were affected by the coding error.

The first two columns of Table 1 provide the estimates in the original report for NPF. The second two columns provide the estimates once the coding error was corrected. The final column provides the page numbers in the report where these estimates are cited. For example, for undergraduate males, the estimate for NPF and NAPF is cited on page 59 (Table 3-4). The estimate for NPF is .9 percent, representing approximately 2,439 victims. According to Table 1, the percentage did not change, but the number of victims went down slightly from the original of 2,498. According to Table 2, a similar change occurred for NAPF.

In some cases, the coding error did not affect the estimates at all. For example, for NPF, the error did not affect the estimate for graduate students identifying as TGQN. The original and revised estimates are the same (107 victims, 4.8 percent).
