With the extension of time, AAU is asking that department reflections be revisited to make any refinements necessary based on conversations about the long-term impacts of COVID-19 and a deeper examination of systemic racism and inequality in academia grounded in the current national discourse.

Reflection Process (750 words or less)

- 1. What have you done to engage students in the process of identifying goals and generating ideas for actions? (i.e., focus groups, town halls, representatives, surveys)
- 2. What have you done to engage faculty in the process of identifying goals and generating ideas for actions? (i.e., faculty meetings, retreats, surveys)
- 3. What have you done to bring students and faculty together to identify shared goals and ideas?

Reflection Outcomes (1500 words or less)

- 4. As a department/program, what aspirations have you identified related to:
 - a. creating more student-centered graduate education?
 - b. making the full range of doctoral career pathways be more visible?
 - c. making the full range of doctoral career pathways be more valued?
 - d. making the full range of doctoral career pathways be more viable?
