

AAU is aware that there is a large body of literature on how people learn as well as a number of valid ways for faculty members to engage in formative assessment of their teaching. This matrix is intended to capture strategies AAU member campuses are using to incorporate evidence beyond student course evaluation in the summative evaluation of faculty members' teaching (e.g., promotion and tenure, and annual/merit reviews). AAU is continuously developing this matrix and considers this a living document. As a critical lever for change, AAU is intentionally working to highlight these strategies across the AAU membership. We are also engaged with national projects focused on this topic.
